

# DUNHAM TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

The Supervisor, Darrell Perkins called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00pm. Members present are Dennis Bischke, Cory Scott, Dave Binz, Kyle Book, Darrell Perkins, Dave Nolan and Whitney Scott. Also present is Township Assessor Hugo Roldan. Electors present are listed on the attached sign-in sheet.

Darrell Perkins made the board aware that the bill listed under the Town Fund for PEAC in the amount \$95.00 was actually now \$190.00 as an updated bill was received the day after our last meeting. Cory Scott made a motion to approve the bills as presented with the update given by Mr. Perkins and the minutes that were mailed Kyle Book seconded. All ayes, no nays.

**Public Participation** - Jim Jeschke wanted to know if the county was going to post a speed limit sign on County Line Road.

**Road Commissioner's Report:** Dave Nolan stated that 200 tons of salt came in. McHenry County Highway Commissioner's meeting will be taking place at Dunham Township this Thursday January 15th, 2026. One topic that will likely be discussed is the McHenry County Bridge Program.

**Supervisor's Report:** Darrell Perkins stated that Dunham Township is close to moving all accounts to Sauk Valley Bank. There are two CD's that are up for renewal. The renewal rate is 9 months at 3.9%. The township still has about \$1600.00 left from referendum money that the township needs to use.

**Clerk's Report:** None

**Assessor's Report:** Hugo Roldan stated that the Senior Citizen Exemption has been raised by the General Assembly. The minimum household income has gone up to \$75,000 in 2026, \$77,000 in 2027, and \$79,000 in 2028. This is great news for seniors.

**Planning Commissioner's Report:** Trevor Berg stated that there is a petition going to the county for the property on Busse Road; they want to take 10 acres of the 40 acres they have and rezone from A1 to A2.
