The Supervisor, Darrell Perkins called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00pm. Members present are Dennis Bischke, Cory Scott, Dave Binz, Kyle Book, Darrell Perkins, Dave Nolan and Whitney Scott. Electors present are listed on the attached sign-in sheet.

Dave Binz made a motion to approve the bills as present and the minutes from the last Dunham Township meeting that were mailed/mailed Dennis Bischke seconded. All ayes, no nays.

Public Participation - None

Road Commissioner's Report: Dave Nolan stated that Dunham Township has ten bridges and four of them are under construction and will be completed before all federal monies stop funding bridges. The other six bridges in the township are in good shape.

Budget: Darrell Perkins asked the board to please review the budget. There were no concerns and everybody agreed that the budget would remain the same. Dave Binz made a motion to accept the budget from last year for next year's budget Cory Scott seconded. All ayes no nays.

Supervisor's Report: Darrell Perkins stated that he is still in the process of trying to get the former supervisors personal information off of some of Dunham Township's recurring bills, in particular Quickbooks. Darrell Perkins and John Pihl are making some headway and will keep working on that process so John Pihl will not be billed and/or will be refunded the amount that was already taken off of his personal credit card.

Clerk's Report: Whitney reminded the board that they should have received their Statement of Economic Interest in their email, she encouraged them to fill it out as soon as possible to avoid any fines.

Assessor's Report: In Hugo's absence Darrell Perkins stated that Hugo had asked him to let the board know a few things. 1. The senior freeze information and forms are available on the county's website. 2. The county is estimating a 10% assessment increase for all assessments and they will have a better, more accurate percentage next month.

Planning Commissioner's Report: None

Old Business: Dave Binz asked if the new storage shed is complete as far as all permits. Dave Noland stated, "That it is a beautiful building and the township has done everything to satisfy storm water." Dave also added that everything is in the building under roof. Darrell Perkins said Dunham Township received a certificate of occupancy.

New Business: Kyle Book asked if the township has a disc to pull the shoulder gravel back to the shoulder and out of the ditch. Dave Noland stated that the township does have a disc and that is one of the duties of the roadworkers.

Dennis Bischke made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dave Binz seconded the motion. All ayes, no nays, and the motion carried.
