

# DUNHAM TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING

The Supervisor, Darrell Perkins called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00pm. Members present are Dennis Bischke, Cory Scott, Dave Binz, Kyle Book, Darrell Perkins, Whitney Scott. Also present was Hugo Roldan, Trevor Berg and Whitney Scott. Dave Binz made a motion to approve the bills as present and the minutes from the last Dunham Township meeting that were mailed/mailed Kyle Book seconded. All ayes, no nays and the motion carried.

**Public Participation - None**

**Road Commissioner's Report:** In Dave Nolan's absence Cory Scott gave the Road Commissioner's report. Cory stated that the salt barn is full because there is talk that salt prices will be going up so Dave Nolan was proactive and purchased salt. Dave will be ordering gravel to complete shoulder graveling this spring.

**Budget:** Darrell Perkins stated that the budget is finished and thanked everyone for the input and help on getting it completed.

**Supervisor's Report:** Darrell Perkins stated that the Comptroller is now sending the checks to the post office. The Spectrum bill should be around \$150.00 a month and not the \$500.00 a month that the Township was being charged. Spectrum was still charging the Township for equipment that was not in use anymore. Darrell also stated that he is in the process of getting a cell phone for the Highway Commissioner and dropping the landline. Darrell is still finishing up switching a few last items to himself, the Supervisor so they are not being sent to John Pihl, the previous Supervisor.

**Clerk's Report:** None

**Assessor's Report:** Hugo stated that the County is no longer mailing out assessment notices if there is not a change in their assessment. There is an equalization factor (which is just under 10%) and if a property falls under the equalization factor they will not receive an assessment in the mail. If residents want their assessment they need to find it online at the county's website. The only people who will receive an assessment in the mail is if a resident's assessment is raised or lowered, it is new construction, and if it's farmland.
